On 7 May 2024, BASF, Infrabel and Combinant discussed the electrification and extension of Railway Line 11. This project is part of Infrabel's Multi-Year Investment Plan and should be operational by the end of 2026. Combinant has therefore committed to electrifying its rail connections as well. These investments are crucial for the future of the site, so that we remain 'future proof and best in class'. The three parties look forward to further cooperation to realise this strategic project. These works will start end of this year and will last for 2 years.
